



Social Media Policy

The San Diego Police Foundation welcomes honest, friendly and open conversation, and values the interaction afforded through social media. We run numerous social media pages and video sharing to promote awareness and engagement in the public safety cause.

While we are keen for supporters and friends to share ideas, experiences and dialog on our page. We reserve the right to remove comments or discussion posts that interfere with a useful and safe experience for everyone, such as comments which:

- Are considered likely to disrupt, provoke, attack or offend others.
- Are off-topic for the thread of conversation in question.
- Are racist, sexist, homophobic, sexually explicit, abusive or otherwise objectionable.
- Contain swear words or other language likely to offend.
- Could break the law, or condone or encourage unlawful activity.
- Advertise products or services for profit or gain.
- Deliberately impersonate someone else.
- Include contact details such as phone numbers, postal or email addresses.
- Describe or encourage activities which could endanger the safety or well-being of others.
- Are considered to be 'spam' (posts containing the same message posted multiple times).
- Are 'trolling', or posting deliberately disruptive statements meant to hijack comment threads or throw discussions off-track, or are repeatedly off-topic for the comment, discussion or post on which you are posting.

By participating, contributors agree to uphold these guidelines.

Contributors who repeatedly breach the guidelines will have their comments removed and may be blocked from further contribution.
