What is America's Finest Motorcycle Ride?

Feel the roar of engines and the pulsing in your veins as you rev-up for this police-escorted motorcycle ride through the heart of San Diego. Starting at one of California's most famous Harley Davidson dealerships, this unforgettable ride spans both coast and mountains including downtown San Diego, the scenic Coronado Bridge, Coronado Island and many more iconic destinations. The ride will last approximately 2-3 hours and each rider will receive a goody bag.

All proceeds will benefit the San Diego Police Foundation, a nonprofit organization supporting the dedicated men and women of the San Diego Police Department.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

FREE Event Shuttle to Harley-Davidson:

We will provide (1) round-trip shuttle for participants from the Convention Center, Hall A (see map below) to the Harley-Davidson San Diego dealership. Shuttles will pick up participants on the outside drive.



Directions to Harley-Davidson:

From the South (Downtown San Diego)

Merge onto I-5 North toward Los Angeles and follow for 7 miles. Take exit 23B toward Balboa Ave East. Turn right onto Garnet Ave and take exit onto Morena Blvd. Follow Morena Blvd for 1 mile, the Harley-Davidson warehouse will be on your right. Follow posted signs for parking behind the warehouse.

From the East (Mission Valley)

Merge onto I-8 West and follow for 2 miles. Take exit 2A to merge onto I-5 North toward Los Angeles and follow for 3.5 miles. Take exit 23B toward Balboa Ave East. Turn right onto Garnet Ave and take exit onto Morena Blvd. Follow Morena Blvd for 1 mile, the Harley-Davidson warehouse will be on your right. Follow posted signs for parking behind the warehouse.

What is included in my registration?

Transportation to and from the Convention Center, one 24-hour bike rental, a loaned motorcycle helmet, complimentary breakfast and lunch and goody bag are included.

What paperwork do I need to bring?

Please complete the following forms and return by **Wednesday, September 28, 2016**. This will help expedite the registration and rental process. Please see below for the required documents:

- Acknowledgement and Assumption of Risk (Harley Davidson)
- Loss Damage Waiver Acknowledgement (Harley Davidson)
- Bike Reservation Form (Harley Davidson)
- Motorcycle Rental Release of Liability / Motorcycle Passenger Release of Liability (same document) (Harley Davidson)
- Helmet Sizing (Super Seer)

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Insurance Information:

Motorcycle insurance is not included, but can be purchased for \$25.00 through San Diego Harley-Davidson. You do have the option of using your own insurance. If you choose to use your own, Harley-Davidson requires proof of insurance on-site as well as a \$500.00 security deposit to be placed on a valid credit card.

Weather and Dress:

As San Diego is frequently sunny, we do experience occasional rain. Please prepare accordingly by bringing the proper motorcycle gear (footwear, jacket, gloves, etc.). You have the option of bringing a helmet, however, these will be provided for you free of charge (see below). *Please note that the ride will take place rain or shine.*

Will food be provided?

Yes, a complimentary breakfast and lunch will be provided to all participating riders and passengers. Please contact the San Diego Police Foundation if you have any known severe food allergies.

Will helmets be provided?

Yes, helmets will be loaned *free of charge* to riders and passengers by Super Seer, an exhibitor at this year's IACP conference. In order to facilitate the proper helmet sizing, please provide your fitted hat size or head measurement using a cloth measuring tape prior to the ride. Super Seer will manufacture specific sizes based on your input and bring the helmet to the dealership for you. Individual sizing can be accomplished at the Harley-Davidson dealership the day of the ride. Steve & Kevin Smith from Super Seer will be at the ride to help in any way possible to make your ride safe and comfortable. Please complete the attached helmet sizing form and return to rosa@sdpolicefoundation.org by **Wednesday, September 28, 2016**.

Where can I get a map of the route?

We will have maps at Harley-Davidson on the day of ride as well as at The San Diego Police Foundation Special Events booth inside the IACP convention.

How long is the motorcycle rental?

The single-rider registration fee of \$125 includes one 24-hour bike rental (the 24-hours will start at the moment of pickup). You have the option of keeping the bike through IACP weekend at an additional \$95.00 per day.

Who is participating?

This ride is open to pre-registered Police Chiefs attending the IACP conference, as well as sponsors, conference exhibitors and various members of the San Diego Police Department. We expect about 150 riders participating.

Experience Level

This is a casual, scenic ride and we welcome licensed, motorcycle riders of all experience levels!
